



OAKWIND TENNIS RULES

- Please keep the court gates closed and the lights off when courts are not in use.
- The following rules must be observed by anyone using the tennis courts:
 - The tennis courts are for the use of Oakwind residents in good standing and their guests only.
 - Guests must be accompanied by a resident.
 - Residents and their guests are responsible for any losses, damages or injuries incurred while on the courts.
 - Basic rules of courtesy should apply at all times while using courts and while waiting for a court.
 - Children who are not playing tennis are not allowed on the courts.
 - The tennis courts are to be used for the sole purpose of playing tennis unless otherwise authorized by the Oakwind Tennis Committee.
 - All courts must be reserved in advanced via email to tennis@oakwindhoa.com.
 - Organized teams must reserve courts through the Oakwind Tennis Committee.
 - Court reservations are limited to a maximum time of two hours per resident or playing group unless ALTA/USTA/Other league matches.
 - At the end of this time, the court becomes “free” to be signed up by another resident, other than yourself or a member of your group. You may continue playing on the court for as long as it remains “free”, but you cannot sign up again yourself.
 - As a courtesy to the other neighbors, if you need to cancel your reservation please contact the Oakwind Tennis Committee or email to tennis@oakwindhoa.com to free the courts availability.
 - There is a 15-minute grace period beyond the registered start time for the court to be used by the person/people that signed up for it before it is declared “free” and available for anyone waiting.
 - Court lights will be turned off shortly after 10:00 p.m. each night. Play must stop promptly at this time.
 - Individual tennis instruction paid or otherwise, must be booked as a normal reservation contacting Oakwind Tennis Committee or by email tennis@oakwindhoa.com and you must indicate in the reservation that it is a “lesson”. Lessons should use courts 3 and 4 unless otherwise assigned by the Oakwind Tennis Committee.
 - Private/group lessons are limited to a maximum of two courts, unless otherwise approved by the Oakwind Tennis Committee.
 - Proper tennis attire (tennis shoes, shirts, etc.) must be worn at all times.
 - Proper net height is 36 inches, and may not be changed to another height at any time.
 - No food is allowed on the courts. Beverages on the court must be in a non-breakable container.
 - No pets, bicycles, playpens, skateboards, skates, or similar equipment is allowed on the tennis courts at any time.
 - The last member on the courts is responsible for turning off the lights, locking gates, and turning off lights under pavilion.
 - All USTA/ALTA/Other matches are allowed to maintain courts until completion.



OAKWIND TENNIS COURT RESERVATIONS

- Reservation times are a maximum of two hours for non-league matches.
- No back to back reservations.
- Reservation forfeited if “no show” after 15 minutes.
- Each ALTA/USTA team is allowed to reserve one lesson or practice per week with court use as follows:
 - One court for a maximum of 4 hours OR two courts for a maximum of 2 hours.
- 4 courts may be reserved by the Oakwind Tennis Committee for simultaneous use to accommodate ALTA/USTA teams during home matches.
- Lessons can be taken on any court as long as it has been reserved in advanced.
- If a scheduling conflict should arise, reserved courts will always have priority over no-reserved or walk-ins.

OAKWIND CAPTAIN'S RULES

- Team Captains and Co-captains are responsible for ensuring their teams to follow the Oakwind Rules for Tennis and Rules for Team Tennis.
- Team Captains are responsible to submit the dates for courts reservations to the Oakwind Tennis Committee as soon as ALTA/USTA/Other has release the play schedules.
- Team captains are responsible to verify that the Oakwind Tennis Committee has reserved courts for home matches.
- Each team's Captain and Co-captain are responsible to ensure all trash from courts; pavilion and surrounding area are cleaned after a match or practice and placed in dumpsters.
- Each team's Captain and Co-captain must report any necessary tennis court repairs to the Oakwind Tennis Committee.
- Captains must provide a form of communication to the Oakwind Tennis Committee before season starts (i.e. email, telephone numbers).

OAKWIND TENNIS ROSTER RULES

- All Oakwind Tennis teams must submit a team roster to the Oakwind Tennis Committee; No resident may be on the roster if their home owner dues are not paid. The rosters, once submitted, will be sent to the homeowners' board for review.
- When enough teams exist that no more teams can be formed under ALTA/USTA/Other rules; teams with the highest % of Oakwind residents will have priority over teams with less residents.
- Each team must have a Captain and Co-captain.
- The team Captain or Co Captain must be an Oakwind resident.
- A team cannot be forced by a resident to remove any non-resident players.
- The Oakwind Tennis Committee is responsible for interpreting the Rules and solving disputes. When solving disputes, teams with the largest percentage of Oakwind Residents will take priority.



OAKWIND TENNIS TEAM RULES

- Anyone wishing to form a team must contact the Oakwind Tennis Committee to discuss availability of courts and times.
- Any ALTA/USTA/Other team registered to play at Oakwind community must have at least 2 Oakwind Residents.
- Non-resident players are not allowed to reserve court time.
- Oakwind resident team players must be present at all team practices.
- At no time can only non-resident team players be the only players present at a team's practice.
- Based on ALTA/USTA/Other requirements, two teams may play matches at the same time, using all four courts. This is to allow as many Oakwind people to play on teams as is possible.
- Rained out matches are to be rescheduled under the individual player's name and team name.
- Profanity, throwing of racquets and any other emotional outbursts will not be tolerated.

OAKWIND PRIVATE AND GROUP LESSONS

- Oakwind HOA does not represent or provide any exclusivity to any coach.
- Oakwind HOA is not responsible for any issues regarding private lessons or represents any coaching staff.
- Oakwind HOA is not responsible for any injuries, damages to property or other during lessons.
- All tennis instructors must have liability insurance. A copy of the policy must be on file with the Oakwind Tennis Committee.
- Any tennis instructor is welcome to provide private or group lessons to any Oakwind resident. For group lessons at least 1 resident needs to be registered and participate during lessons.
- At no time can only non-residents be during lesson time.
- Coaches or other non-resident should not be in possession or keep a key to access the tennis courts or common areas.
- Coaches are fully responsible to maintain the courts clean and free of trash, damage.
- Coaches should notify immediately the Oakwind Tennis Committee of any incident or non-emergency accident.
- Coaches are responsible to call 911 in case of any emergency during lessons.
